Intel Oregon Champion's Award

The Champion's Award is the most prestigious award that any team can win. It celebrates the ultimate success of the *FIRST* mission and FLL values. It measures how the team members inspire and motivate others about the excitement of science and technology, solve problems, and demonstrate respect and gracious professionalism to everyone involved in the competition.

Champion's Award teams must perform well in the equally weighted Robot Design, Robot Performance, Project Presentation and Teamwork categories. Judges also assess the team's adherence to FLL values and their overall impressions of each team's performance and participation at the tournament.

Tech America Young Team Award

This award is like the Champion's Award except that it is restricted to teams made up of children 11 years old and younger.

Rookie Team Award

This award is like the Champion's Award except that it is restricted to teams made up of children and their adult coaches and mentors who are participating in an FLL tournament season for the first time.

Rockwell Collins Robot Performance Award

Each team demonstrates its robot three times on the Smart Move playing field during the Championship Tournament. The referees score the results obtained by the team's robot each time. The highest of the three scores for each team is used to determine the team's ranking in the Robot Performance category.

RadiSys Robot Design Award

Judges look for teams whose work stands out for innovation, mechanical design, programming, understanding of the design process and overall quality. To assess innovation, the judges watch the robots work, looking for things that make them say "Wow!"

Bonneville Power Project Award

FLL presents the Project Award to the team whose quality research, innovative solutions, and creative presentation best reflect an in-depth understanding of the various scientific disciplines and issues involved with the Challenge project. Only teams that complete all three parts of the Project assignment will receive consideration for awards.

PH Tech Teamwork Award

Teamwork is critical to succeed in *FIRST* LEGO League and is the key ingredient in any team effort. FLL presents this award to the team that best demonstrates extraordinary enthusiasm, an exceptional partnership, and the practice of FLL values.

Award Allocation

No team will receive more than one award. The Judges assign awards starting with the Champion's Award. When a team is assigned an award it is taken out of the running for all of the other awards. This assures that many teams will be honored for what they have accomplished during the FIRST LEGO League season.
